SUBJECT: Approve First Amendment to Cooperative Agreement with County of Riverside, Fire Department for Fire Protection, Fire Prevention, Rescue, Fire Marshal and Medical Emergency Services

RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council approve the first amendment extending the term of the Cooperative Agreement with County of Riverside, Fire Department to provide fire protection, fire prevention, rescue, Fire Marshal and medical emergency services for the City of Temecula through October 30, 2025.

BACKGROUND: Since the City of Temecula's incorporation, Fire services have been provided through a Cooperative Fire Service Agreement to provide fire protection, fire prevention, rescue, fire marshal and medical aid with the County of Riverside. The current Cooperative Agreement expires June 30, 2025.

The County and the City are requesting a 4-month extension of the current Cooperative Agreement to complete the ongoing negotiations of a new 5-year Cooperative Agreement. The 4-month extension would extend the current Cooperative Agreement term from June 30, 2025, to October 30, 2025. The terms included in the existing Cooperative Agreement would extend unchanged until a new Cooperative Agreement is approved by the City and County, or the 4-month extension expires.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no specific cost associated with approving a 4-month extension of the Cooperative Agreement. The costs associated with delivery of Fire related services would continue at the rates and terms defined in the current Cooperative Agreement.
