SUBJECT: Adopt Resolution Approving Agreement with Rain Drop Products, LLC for the Purchase and Installation of the Reservoir and Related Equipment at Eagle Soar Playground

RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council approve:

1. A resolution entitled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMECULA APPROVING THAT CERTAIN AGREEMENT ENTITLED “PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF TEMECULA AND RAIN DROP PRODUCTS, LLC, FOR THE RESERVOIR AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AT THE EAGLE SOAR PLAYGROUND SPLASH PAD AT MIKE NAGGAR COMMUNITY PARK”

2. An additional budget appropriation of \$15,000 from Measure S to cover the agreement.

BACKGROUND: Utilizing a cooperative agreement with Sourcewell, a complete proposal was requested from Rain Drop Products, LLC by the Public Works Department. The proposal was for a total amount of \$314,408.37. Of this, \$53,815 is for the equipment purchase, and \$251,940 is the cost of labor and installation. The City received a 10% discount through Sourcewell membership, leaving the total after taxes and shipping fees to \$288,513.68

In early June of 2025, the Eagle Soar Splash pad experienced an underground equipment failure in the reservoir tank and water circulation system. The result of the failure required the complete closure of the splash pad until repairs can be made.

Rain Drop Products, LLC is a nationally recognized manufacturer and designer of aquatic play equipment, specializing in splash pads, water play features, and related mechanical systems. The City has worked with Rain Drop Products, LLC in the past and has maintained a successful professional relationship for maintenance care of the Eagle Soar Splash Pad. Therefore, the staff recommends the approval of the Resolution and Agreement with Rain Drop Products, LLC, for the Purchase and Installation for the Reservoir and Related Equipment at Eagle Soar Playground.

FISCAL IMPACT: The Council approved a \$300,000 appropriation for this project at their November 18, 2025 CIP Workshop. An additional appropriation of \$15,000 from Measure S is needed to cover the full cost of the agreement.
