SUBJECT: Discussion of Portable Restroom Rentals and Services at City Parks (At the Request of Subcommittee Members Schwank and Stewart)

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors discuss placing portable restrooms and services at select City parks and provide related direction.

BACKGROUND: The previous Parks, Recreation and Community Services Subcommittee (Council Members Alexander and Schwank) met on September 24, 2024, and received an update that Long Canyon Creek Park and Vail Ranch Park had been awarded construction contracts for modular restrooms. Staff also reported suitability of portable restrooms at various park locations, including cost estimates and servicing requirements. The then subcommittee approved portable restroom placement at Serena Hills and Butterfield Stage Road Parks and recommended staff continue investigation of optimal restroom locations and follow up with the subcommittee in the future.

On June 17, 2025, the current Parks, Recreation and Community Services Subcommittee (Council Members Schwank and Stewart) met and received an update from staff on potential portable restroom locations. The current subcommittee recommended placements at Temecula Creek Trail Park, Butterfield Stage Park, Serena Hills Park, and the Murrieta Creek Trail.

It is recommended that the Board of Directors discuss the item and provide general direction regarding the same.

FISCAL IMPACT: Costs are appropriated in the current Annual Operating Budget.
