DESIGNATING AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE APPLICATIONS AND DOCUMENTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF OBTAINING FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR ANY EXISTING OR FUTURE GRANT PROGRAM INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO FEDERALLY DECLARED DISASTER (DR), **FIRE MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT** (FMAG), **ONLY DISASTER** CALIFORNIA **STATE** (CDAA), **SERVICES PROGRAM** IMMEDIATE (ISP), HAZARD GRANT PROGRAM (HMGP), BUILDING MITIGATION INFRASTRUCTURE **AND** RESILIENT **COMMUNITIES** (BRIC), FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FMA), **AND** NATIONAL **EARTHQUAKE HAZARDS** REDUCTION PROGRAM (NEHRP)

BACKGROUND: To be eligible to receive financial assistance and grant reimbursement under the Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) FEMA-5451-FM-CA for the Fairview Fire, CalOES is requiring a resolution adopted by the City Council that designates certain city officials as eligible to apply for and receive federal financial assistance under the above-mentioned grant programs but more specifically FEMA-5451-FM-CA for the Fairview Fire.

This resolution would authorize the City Manager or designee to execute and submit official correspondence and applications on behalf of the City of Temecula.
