SUBJECT: Approve First Amendment with County of Riverside for Library Services at the Ronald H. Roberts Temecula Public Library

RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council approve the first amendment with the County of Riverside to extend the term of the agreement for an additional two years through 2028.

BACKGROUND: The Ronald H. Roberts Temecula Public Library opened in December of 2006, and was rededicated in honor of former Mayor/Council Member Ronald H. Roberts in 2016. The Library serves approximately 20,000 patrons monthly and has the highest circulation in Riverside County. Since the opening of the Library, the City has been in contract with Riverside County to provide library staffing, collections support, and a variety of other services through their contract with Library Systems and Services, Inc. (LS&S).

On September 14, 2021, the City and the County of Riverside entered into a five-year Agreement in the amount of \$153,000 with a 10% contingency per year to provide library operation services at the Ronald H. Roberts Temecula Public Library. On April 28, 2026, the Library Services Ad Hoc Subcommittee (Alexander/Schwank) met to review proposed new language and cost structure for the agreement which had been provided by the County. Upon review, the Subcommittee recommended that City staff request an extension of the current agreement terms to provide the City with sufficient time to conduct a feasibility study to assess its options for library services. The County was amenable to this extension of existing terms.

This amendment shall extend the term of the current agreement by two years. All other terms of the agreement will remain unchanged.

FISCAL IMPACT: Funds for each year will be allocated as part of the budget process
