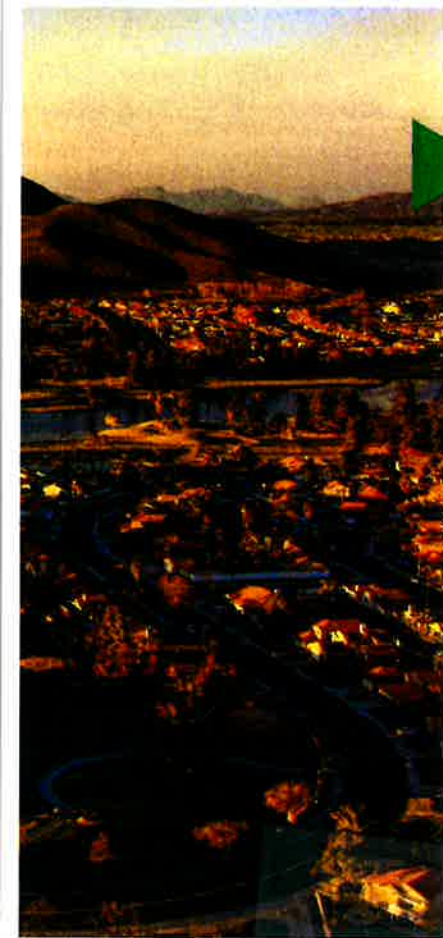
As our region grows and energy needs change, planning ahead is essential to keep electricity reliable for homes, schools, and businesses.
