

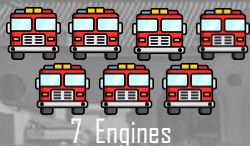

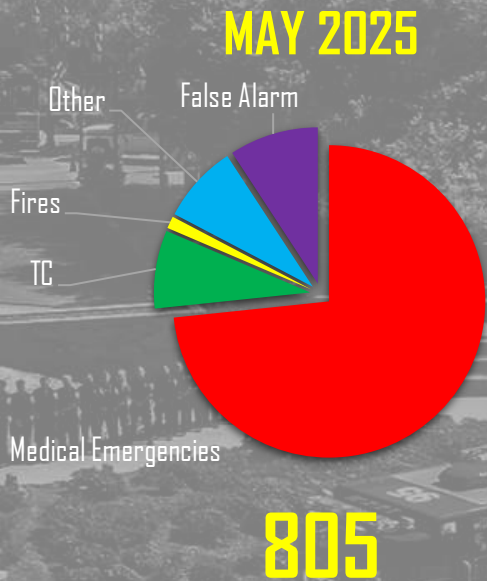

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- DEM hosted the Wide Area Search Course for 45 students providing them with critical skills in the search of missing or at-risk residents and to provide support to our law enforcement partners
- DEM conducted a Community Seminar on Pet and Wildfire Preparedness at the Library
- DEM and TCC provided direct support to the Joint RSD/CAL Fire Active Shooter Exercise held at the Stampede
- DEM held the kickoff meeting for the City Wide Mass Evacuation Planning effort
- DEM and TCC provided firefighter REHAB operations in support of a structure fire within the City
- DEM has partnered with the City of Riverside to utilize Meridian Barriers (a shared regional asset) for City events under a Mutual Aid Agreement for the remainder of 2025
