Paralympic Integration and Making Los Angeles and the Games Accessible**

This session will focus on introducing the Paralympic Movement with a video and overview of the Paralympic Games, and provide an overview of the Paralympic venues planned for 2028. Discussion will center on the City of Paris approach, including perspective from Paralympians who competed in Paris 2024. Topics include: 1) accessibility in transportation and the first/last mile to venues; 2) inclusivity for people with disabilities in the organization of the Games and festivities; and, 3) the creation of enhanced accessibility neighborhoods. The panel will discuss LA's unique challenges and solicit feedback from the audience on how to best address these and build an inclusive process leading up to the Games. Followed by Q&A.
