CONFERENCE WITH REAL PROPERTY NEGOTIATORS. The City Council convened in closed session pursuant to Government Code Section 54956.8 regarding the acquisition of an approximate 40,929 square foot permanent easement for public use, namely public street, bridge, public utility, drainage and all uses necessary or convenient thereto (Subject Easement) in connection with the proposed Murrieta Creek Bridge at Overland Drive Project (PW 16-05) (Project). The Subject Easement is located on that certain approximate 539,273 square foot (12.38 acres) real property improved with a flood control channel located on the section of the Murrieta Creek Flood Channel east of Diaz Road at the north end of Avenida Alvarado, just south of Winchester Road, and identified as Riverside County Tax Assessor's Parcel Number 909-120-016 (Property) owned by the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District. The negotiators for the City are Ron Moreno, William Becerra, Anissa Sharp and the City's acquisition consultant Kim Bibolet of Monument (City Acquisition Consultant). Under negotiations are the price and terms of the acquisition of the Subject Easement.

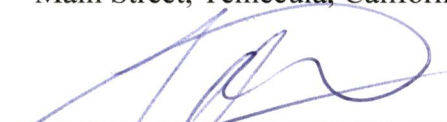
CITY ATTORNEY REPORT
