5. Award Consultant Agreement with Fehr and Peers for the Local Roadway Safety Plan Update Project, PW25-03

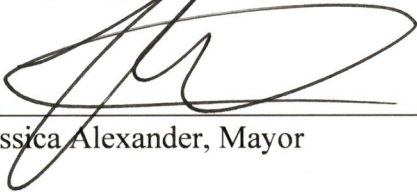
