SUBJECT: Approve Second Amendment with VisionOne, Inc. for Theater Ticketing Software

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors approve the second amendment with VisionOne, Inc. for theater ticketing software, to increase the total not to exceed payment amount by \$10,000, for a total agreement amount of \$210,000.

BACKGROUND: On July 1, 2021, the City and VisionOne, Inc. entered into a multi-year agreement in the amount of \$120,000 to provide ticketing software services for the Old Town Temecula Theater. On June 11, 2024, the City and VisionOne, Inc. entered into the First Amendment to that agreement to extend the term of the agreement for an additional two years through June 30, 2026, and accordingly increased the payment to \$200,000.

Staff now desires to increase the total not to exceed payment by an additional \$10,000 to account for final invoices during the end of the agreement's term.

FISCAL IMPACT: Adequate funds are appropriated in the necessary account.
