SUBJECT: Approve First Amendment with AppleOne for Temporary Staffing Services

RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council approve the first amendment to the agreement with AppleOne, to increase the payment amount of \$135,000 for a total agreement amount of \$300,000.

BACKGROUND: The City of Temecula has utilized AppleOne for temporary staffing services to provide supplemental temporary employment services on an as-needed basis. Each Departments' operating budgets have included funding for temporary employee needs each fiscal year. Temporary staffing ensures voids are filled within all City departments to manage workflow and meet their operational needs.

FISCAL IMPACT: Adequate funds are budgeted within each department to fund temporary staffing.
