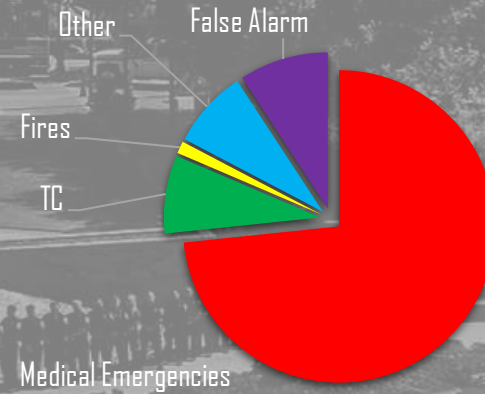

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## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- DEM / TCC delivered the city's first Spanish CERT Course with resounding success
- Team Temecula successfully managed several PSPS events in January during unprecedented winds
- DEM is working with Public Works to develop Mitigation Projects in support of the Hazard Mitigation Plan
- DEM will be undertaking the development of the city's first Mass Evacuation Plan in 2025
- DEM is working with Community Development to ensure compliance with AB2140
  - Adoption of the LHMP into the Safety Element – place on file with CalDES
  - Reduction in Temecula's cost share from 25% to 6.25% for disasters / emergencies
