Equipment Upgrade - Citywide, PW19-10

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the City Council:

1. Accept the Improvements for the Pedestrian Signal Equipment Upgrade - Citywide, PW19-10, as complete; and

- 2. Direct the City Clerk to file and record the Notice of Completion, release the Performance Bond; and
- 3. Release the Labor and Materials Bond seven months after filing the Notice of Completion if no liens have been filed.

**BACKGROUND:** On March 23, 2021, the City Manager, under the authorities delegated by the City Council of the City of Temecula in Resolution 2020-83, approved the plans and specifications and authorized the Department of Public Works to solicit bids for the Pedestrian Signal Equipment Upgrade - Citywide Project, PW19-10.

The Pedestrian Signal Equipment Upgrade - Citywide Project installed pedestrian countdown signal heads, ADA compliant pedestrian pushbuttons, and upgraded traffic signal controllers to improve safety and operations at signalized intersections citywide including the Butterfield Stage Road, Redhawk Parkway, Pechanga Parkway, Rancho California Road, Temecula Parkway, and Ynez Road corridors.

Baker Electric, Inc. has completed the work in accordance with the approved plans and specifications to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works/City Engineer. All work is warranted for a period of one year from July 18, 2022, the date the City obtained "beneficial use" of the Project. The retention for this project will be released pursuant to the provisions of Public Contract Code 7107.

The original and final contract amount is \$773,060. There were no change orders on the project.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** There is no fiscal impact associated with accepting the Project and filing the Notice of Completion.
