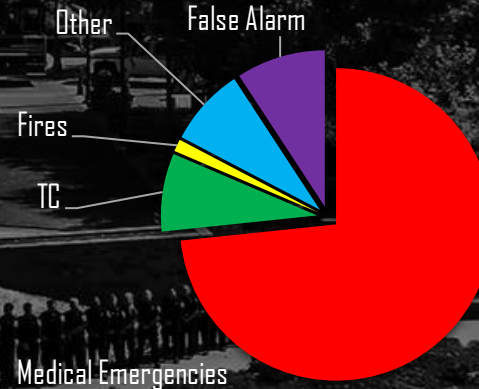

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Temecula Citizen Corps delivered the Adult CERT Course graduating 18 students.
- Emergency Management conducted 11 Shake Out Drills validating current City procedures for facility evacuation.
- The City of Temecula Fire and Emergency Management in collaboration with Rancho Water have begun discussions regarding the installation of a Heli-hydrant supporting area firefighting operations.
- Emergency Management has completed the first CERT Trailer Deployment pre-positioning disaster assets across the city in multiple strategic locations.
- The City's very first Disaster Debris Management Plan (DDMP) has been approved by the City Council

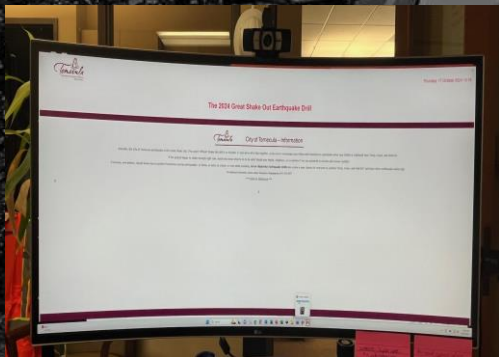

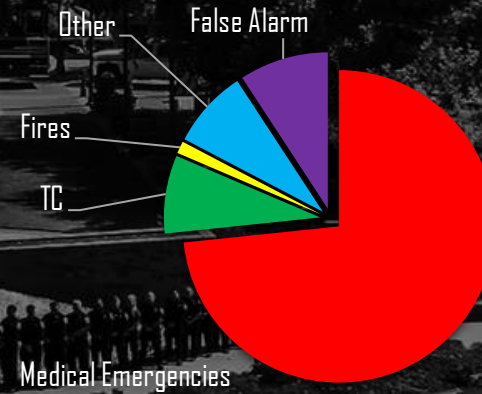

- In collaboration with TVE2, hosted a Debris Management Teaming Fair with DRC Emergency Services to solicit and obtain subcontractors from the Temecula area to support debris management operations
- OEM and the TCC conducted the final TEEN CERT Course of 2024 with 36 graduates
- Attended the California Mass Care Table-Top Exercise with CalOES Southern Section solidifying relationships and processes
- Attended a Dam Intrusion Table-Top Exercise with Temecula Valley Hospital to discuss rapid processes and procedures for vertical evacuation during a catastrophic loss of the Vail Lake Dam
