**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TEMECULA ADOPTING THE 2022-2027 LOCAL
HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (LHMP) ANNEX TO THE
RIVERSIDE COUNTY OPERATIONAL AREA MULTI-
JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN INTO
THE PUBLIC SAFETY ELEMENT OF THE CITY'S
GENERAL PLAN**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMECULA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS
FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires each local jurisdiction to implement a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan ("LHMP") approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") in order to qualify for Pre-Disaster Mitigation and Post-Disaster Mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Temecula's ("City's") LHMP outlines mitigation actions to reduce or eliminate potential risks to community members and facilities from future natural hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services ("Cal OES") and FEMA have reviewed the 2022-2027 LHMP Annex to the Riverside County Operational Area Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan ("LHMP Annex"); and

WHEREAS, the City's 2022-2027 LHMP Annex was adopted by the City on July 11, 2023 pursuant to Resolution No. 2023-059 and deemed approvable pending adoption by FEMA on June 27, 2023. The LHMP Annex is on file with the Office of the City Clerk and easily accessible and electronically available for public viewing online; and

WHEREAS, the City now seeks to formally adopt the 2022-2027 LHMP Annex into the Public Safety Element of the City's General Plan in accordance with Assembly Bill 2140 ("AB 2140"), thereby complying with statutory requirements and augmenting its emergency planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the 2022-2027 LHMP Annex into the General Plan by reference would benefit the City.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMECULA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Temecula amends the Public Safety Element of the City's General Plan as shown on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, to adopt the 2022-2027 City of Temecula Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Annex to

the Riverside County Operational Area Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan into the Public Safety Element.

Section 2. The Emergency Manager shall provide FEMA with a signed LHMP Annex adoption resolution in order to obtain official approval, and provide required materials to Cal OES for review and subsequent approval.

Section 3. Environmental Findings. The City hereby makes the following environmental findings and determinations in connection with this action:

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”), staff has determined that the proposed project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) since there is no possibility of potential significant effect on the environment because the LHMP Annex was previously adopted by the City and this resolution merely adopts the LHMP into the Public Safety Element of the General Plan.
