RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council accept the notice of draft amendments to the Conflict of Interest Code for the 2022 calendar year pursuant to Government Code 87306.5 and direct the City Clerk to publish the Notice of Intent.

BACKGROUND: As the Code reviewing body under the Political Reform Act, the City Council is required to review the City's Conflict of Interest Code biennially to determine whether or not an amendment to the Code is necessary. The attached draft Exhibit A makes proposed changes to the Code based on conditions occurring since the last update in 2020. The attached resolution is in draft form and the Notice of Intent must be posted to begin the 45-day public comment period on the proposed changes. A final version will be brought back to the Council for approval on November 8, 2022. The proposed changes reflect title changes of positions that already exist in the code, reclassifications, vacancies, and/or the addition and deletion of positions based on an examination of their involvement in the decision making process. The changes are reflected in underline/strikeout format in the draft Exhibit A. The City Attorney, City Clerk and Executive Management staff have reviewed the proposed changes and concur with the recommendation.
