On-Call Striping for Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the City Council approve the First Amendment to the Agreement with Pacific Striping, Inc., in the amount of \$70,000, for on-call striping for Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program and Trails and Bicycle Facilities Master Plan.

**BACKGROUND:** In July 2018, the City Manager executed an Agreement with Pacific Striping, Inc., in the amount of \$30,000 for On-Call Striping for Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program and Trails and Bicycle Facilities Master Plan.

Pacific Striping, Inc., has provided on-call services for the past several years, which includes the installation of striping for neighborhood traffic calming features and bicycle lane facilities Citywide.

Staff recommends increasing the Agreement in the amount of \$70,000, for a total Agreement amount of \$100,000. The additional Agreement amount will be used to implement bicycle lane striping included in the SB 821 (Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Program) grant received from the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) in 2017-18.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Adequate funds are available in the Department of Public Works, Traffic Engineering Division's Operating Budget Fiscal Year 2018-19 and Capital Improvement Program Fiscal Years 2019-2023.
