Project Description: This project will establish programs that will remove boardwalk plank boards and replace them with colored concrete sidewalks stamped with wood grain finish similar to what was installed with the new Main Street bridge.

Benefit / Core Value: This project promotes a sustainable walkable surface that will require little maintenance. New sidewalks will enhance American with Disabilities Act(ADA) access. It will also promote a "walkable" community by connecting the City. In addition, this project satisfies the City's Core Values of a Healthy and Livable City and Transportation Mobility and Connectivity.
