BACKGROUND: The City of Temecula currently has an inventory of 40 parks and 11 facilities available to the public, and ensuring the safety and enjoyment of all patrons is the highest priority. In response to concerns regarding an increase in incidents at City facilities and parks, staff has been investigating various options for enhancing the security at parks and facilities. Recent incidents have included drug and alcohol possession and use, vandalism, intoxication, and fighting, which adversely impact the enjoyment by the public of these amenities. Additionally, these incidents have the potential to jeopardize the safety of City staff and patrons and are costly to address.

Following discussion with the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Subcommittee, staff was directed to recommend parking restrictions at all Community Services facilities and parks. Staff consulted with law enforcement, staff from schools operating adjacent to parks, and City staff working directly in each of the facilities in order to develop a comprehensive set of recommendations to curtail negative incidents while preserving access to parks and facilities for patrons. Staff therefore recommends prohibiting overnight parking at all parks and facilities, and changing park operational hours to improve enforceability and decrease unwanted activities. This would require an amendment to section 12.04.190 of the Temecula Municipal Code regarding City park hours as well as the adoption of a resolution revising the designated parking hours in City parking lots.
