A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMECULA APPROVING A LIST OF PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMECULA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The City Council hereby finds, determines and declares that:

- A. Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and
- B. SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Temecula are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and
- C. On April 24, 2018, the City Council approved a list of projects for Fiscal Year 2018-19; and
- D. On April 9, 2019, the City Council approved a list of projects for Fiscal Year 2019-20; and
- E. The California Transportation Commission (CTC) adopted the Local Streets and Roads Funding Program 2019 Reporting Guidelines at the August 15, 2018 meeting; and
- F. Section 2 of the Local Streets and Roads Funding Program 2019 Reporting Guidelines, Funding Program Objectives and Statutory Requirements, indicates that prior to receiving an apportionment of RMRA funds from the Controller in a fiscal year, a city or county must submit to the Commission a list of projects proposed to be funded with these funds; and
- G. The City of Temecula must adopt by resolution at a regular public meeting a list of all projects proposed to receive RMRA funds; and
- H. The City of Temecula is set to receive an estimated amount of \$1,827,342 in Fiscal Year 2020-21 for Local Streets and Roads from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funded by SB 1; and
- I. The SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

Section 2. Approval of the SB 1 Project List for Fiscal Year 2020-21
