RECOMMENDATION: That the Public/Traffic Safety Commission review the HOA Assisted Traffic Calming Brochure as presented for distribution to HOA's and residents.

BACKGROUND: A request was received from residents to investigate speeding on Shasta Lane and Gold Mine Drive within the Wolf Creek neighborhood. Due to the layout of the Wolf Creek development, cut-through traffic is unlikely; however, residents themselves may be speeding.

An informational brochure was prepared for Home Owner Association Assisted Traffic Calming for review by the Public/Traffic Safety Commission. Comments were received and the brochure revised to include comments from the commission.
