My family first moved to Temecula in July of 1991, on my fifth birthday. I grew up alongside our city and witnessed, first hand, how the City's General Plan came to fruition. Temecula's status as one of the safest cities in the nation isn't an accident, nor did our transportation network spontaneously appear. Temecula was built on a framework of guiding documents-- 30-year plans, carefully stewarded through the years from one civic leader to the next. I'm eager to help carry the torch forward and contribute more directly to the community which gave so much to me, growing up. After graduating from TVHS in 2004 and leaving town for college and work, I developed a new appreciation for Temecula and often found myself feeling homesick. It was during this time that I became a regular viewer of Temecula's City Council meetings. These recordings served as a window back into my home until finally, in 2017, Ashley and I were able to move back to Temecula permanently. Since then, I've attended meetings of the City Council, I-15 Task Force, City Sustainability Program Committee, Public / Traffic Safety Commission, Planning Commission, and numerous community workshops and city events. I've enjoyed interacting with my neighbors, councilmembers and city staff on various agenda items, from redistricting to regional transportation issues. I'd love to work with you more closely. I know I can be a greater asset to our community if entrusted with the responsibility of serving on the Public / Traffic Safety commission. 2020 has been a transformational year for my family and for our community. I started a new job at Hemet Unified School District, where I've been hard at work building the digital infrastructure that supports the district's distance learning program. Working in the public sector has given me new perspective into the challenges families are facing across Riverside County. I've witnessed, on the front line, how inequity in internet access can lead to an opportunity gap in public education. At HUSD, we're aggressively taking on the problem of internet inequality by building out our own LTE network to serve underserved communities in the valleys east of Temecula. It's often been said that there's no one, right way to be a commissioner, so I'd like to briefly describe the kind of commissioner I'd aspire to be. The basic function of a commissioner, as I understand it, is to listen to the City's experts, pour over the details, provide another set of eyes and fine-tune projects (or challenge them if necessary) before they reach the City Council. Beyond that, as a commissioner I would serve as a conduit to the public. I view civic engagement as a two-way street-- that means not only listening to and weighing public feedback, but also participating in community outreach and education efforts. Additionally, I believe that this position would empower me to be a stronger advocate for our community on regional issues which are normally beyond the scope of the commission. Temecula is on the right path and I trust our current leaders with the future of our city. Still, I'm ready to come off the bench, put my nose to the grindstone and get to work. There will always be new challenges and opportunities ahead of us and I know I can help our city meet them.

Our quaint little valley has grown since then, but to me Temecula will always be one city. No matter how our district lines may shift over the years, as a commissioner I will always search for the most equitable solution and act in the interest of the city at large. Modern Temecula is increasingly diverse, now comprised of many different communities of interest. While Equity will be my guiding principle as a commissioner, awareness of Temecula's diversity is just as important in shaping projects to reflect the needs of each neighborhood. A good PTSC commissioner recognizes that a traffic light isn't the answer to every problem. For example, the roundabout at Ynez and La Paz was designed to fit the rural character of the Los Ranchitos community and pay tribute to the equestrian culture. As a commissioner, I will listen intently to my neighbors, respect their variety of thought and perspective, and tailor fit solutions to neighborhood values. As Temecula looks to the future, we must also address the need for greater diversity in our transportation infrastructure in order to serve our shifting demographics. For example, as a large number of residents near retirement age in the next decade, now is the time to begin investing more robustly in buses to serve our senior population. More broadly, the PTS Commission plays a vital role in connecting people and places. We have a diverse population, and the City Council, Planning Commission and Community Services Commission have made strides towards developing inclusive housing options, services and amenities. However, to be considered a fully inclusive city, we must also support inclusive modes of transportation.
