Exempt Status: (*check one*) Ministerial (Section 21080(b)(1); Section 15268); Categorical Exemption: (Section 15301, Class 1, Declared Emergency (Section 21080(b)(3); Section 15269(a)); Existing Facilities) Emergency Project (Section 21080(b)(4); Section 15269(b)(c)) Other: Categorical Exemption: (Section 15303, Statutory Exemptions (Section Number: Class 3, Conversion of Small Structures) Statement of Reasons Supporting the Finding that the Project is Exempt: The request for a Modification Application to modify an existing building and Conditional Use Permit for a wireless telecommunication facility to accommodate new wireless equipment and increase the height of the existing building by 16 feet involves a negligible expansion of the existing and expected uses. These are considered minor alterations to an existing building and, therefore, are exempt from further environmental review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301. In addition, the construction of additional wireless telecommunication facilities and a new 15'x21' equipment enclosure involves the construction of small structures and/or conversion of existing small structures and is therefore exempt from environmental review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303.
