SUBJECT: Pauba Road Pavement Rehab Project Striping Plans

RECOMMENDATION: That the Public/Traffic Safety Commission approve the striping changes on Pauba Road.

BACKGROUND: City of Temecula staff were asked to consider a request from City Council Member Schwank that the striping plan for the Pauba Road Pavement Rehab project be revised. The revision would involve allowing for bikes lanes to be added on both the South and North side of Pauba Road. This change will require modifying the current striping plan (Exhibit A) from two lanes to one lane heading East and moving the centerline to the South (Exhibit B).

The change would have minor fiscal impact and is able to be completed as a part of the current Pauba Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project.

FISCAL IMPACT: Minor cost associated with the recommended action.
