BACKGROUND: On July 26, 1994, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 94-79 setting forth the rules of order for conduct of City Council meetings. On March 22, 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 11-27 setting forth the time limit for public comments. The City Council approved the creation of a City Council Protocol Manual as part of Phase II of its Race, Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Initiative on July 14, 2020, and approved the general policy contents of the City Council Protocol Manual on July 13, 2021. On August 24, 2021, the City Council requested that the preparation of City Council Policies relating to the Code of Conduct, Rules of Order, Agenda Placement, Request of Staff, and Public Participation In Meetings be expedited for consideration. The proposed resolution and ordinance are before the City Council for consideration as a result.
