SUBJECT:	Approve Second Amendment with M & J Paul Enterprises dba Jolly Jumps for Additional Event Services

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors approve the second amendment with M & J Paul Enterprises dba Jolly Jumps for additional event services and increase payment in the amount of \$30,000, for a total agreement amount of \$90,000.

BACKGROUND: On April 9, 2018, the Board of Directors approved a Non-Exclusive Event Service Provider Agreement with M & J Paul Enterprises dba Jolly Jumps to provide Event Services through June 2020. On June 27, 2019, the Board of Directors approved a First Amendment entitled Agreement for Event Service Provider, to extend the term of the Agreement through June 2022, and increase the payment in the amount of \$30,000. As our traditional events are returning to normal and a few new events are in the planning stages we are in need of additional funds for event services. M & J Paul Enterprises dba Jolly Jumps is a long-standing vendor and we look forward to continuing to work with them on upcoming events.

FISCAL IMPACT: Adequate funds of \$30,000 have been allocated in the Temecula Community Services District's Fiscal Year 2021-22 Annual Operating Budget.
